Day 2: Wilpena Pound Visit the Aboriginal art site at Yourambulla Caves. Venture into Wilpena Pound for a bush walk and enjoy magnificent views. Drive along the northern side of Wilpena through the famous Bunyerroo and Brachina Gorges to spot wildlife and pass through 130 million years geological history. (BLD)

Day 3: Oodnadatta Track Leave the rugged mountain scenery and head north into the outback. Hit the famous

Oodnadatta Track and follow the historic camel route and the Old Ghan Railway. Visit the Arabunna Aboriginal Centre at Marree to see aboriginal art and weapons, culture and local history. Cross the dingo fence and onto Lake Eyre South and cool off in a thermal waterhole. Enjoy a cool beer at the famous outback pub at William Creek and set up camp on the world's largest cattle station. (BLD)

Day 4: Coober Pedy Head into Coober Pedy, the opal capital of the world. Go underground and learn the techniques of mining and production before heading onto the Painted and Simpson Deserts. Set up camp and watch a spectacular outback sunset. (BLD)

Day 5: Simpson Desert Wander through the old railway town of Oodnadatta, then into the Simpson Desert to perhaps deliver mail and provisions to the remote cattle stations. 4WD over the red sand dunes of this spectacular desert and watch out for wild camels, horses, dingoes and wedge tail eagles. Enjoy lunch and a swim at Eringa Waters before arriving to the campsite. (BLD)

Day 6: Finke and Uluru Head to Finke, a traditional Aboriginal community to meet local Aboriginal people. Journey past Lamberts Centre, the geographical centre of Australia. Arrive in time for a spectacular sunset over the spiritual monolith of Uluru, home of the traditional custodians, the Anangu people. (BLD)

Day 7: Uluru This morning watch the sunrise over Uluru and take a guided walk around the rock and learn of its spiritual importance to the Aboriginal people. Continue to the Cultural Centre for lunch and listen to stories of the Anangu. (BLD)

Day 8: Kata Tjuta Head to the spectacular and ancient rock formations of Kata Tjuta (The Olgas). Learn about bush tucker and photograph beautiful desert scenery. After lunch continue towards Watarrka National Park and set up camp in the red sand hills protected by desert oak trees. (BLD)

Day 9: Kings Canyon Explore Kings Canyon and trek to the Amphitheatre and The Lost City, or swim in the Garden of Eden waterhole. This afternoon gaze over the huge comet crater of Gosse Bluff. Time permitting, visit Hermannsburg and Palm Valley. Roll out your swag for the final evening under the stars. (BLD)

Day 10: West MacDonnell Ranges and Alice Springs Travel along the West MacDonnell Ranges stopping at Glen Helen Gorge and Ormiston Gorge. Swim at Ellery Creek Big Hole or Simpsons Gap before arriving in Alice Springs at approximately 5pm. (BL)

Arrive in picturesque Mannum and board the waiting coach for a historic tour of this small township. Re-trace the colourful history of several pioneering families whose efforts shaped the successful development of this region. Visit the 'Olden Days, Olden Ways' Museum in Mannum, where you will find a large collection of historic memorabilia.

Enjoy a themed 'Australiana Night' this evening and sample some traditional bush foods such as emu, kangaroo, damper bread, fresh water yabbies, lemon myrtle, wild bush tomatoes and quandongs (wild peaches), combined into exciting creations by the onboard chefs. Join the resident ecologist for a Nocturnal Discovery Tour to see native flora and fauna. (BLD)

Day 3: After breakfast, continue upstream and pass fascinating Wongulla, where some fifty years ago, 20 million year old petrified remains of a shark was found. Arriving at the pioneering township of Swan Reach, disembark with a local guide to visit Murray Aquaculture to see one of many species of crayfish found in Australia. The Murray Expedition continues to Blanchetown, site of the Lock and Weir No. 1 on the River Murray, an excellent feeding place for pelicans and dozens of species of water birds. (BLD)

Day 4: Wake in one of the most unspoilt and picturesque areas of the River Murray. Join a guided walk to see evidence of an ancient Aboriginal civilization and learn about the Aboriginal tribe that once lived in this area. Cruise

downstream through magnificent lagoons and spectacular scenery. Join your guide through the lagoons and inlets to see a variety of species of birdlife. This evening enjoy a traditional Australian barbecue on shore with entertainment around a blazing campfire. (BLD)

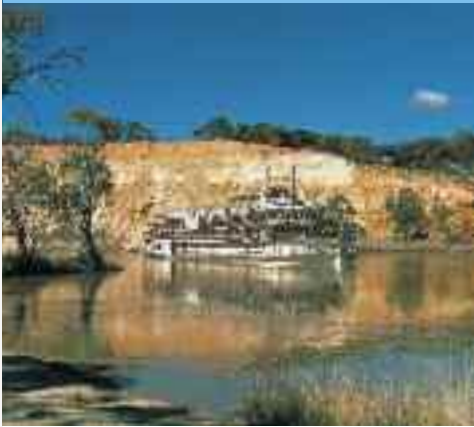
